



Wagyu is a Japanese breed of bovine, of native origin, where “WA” (和), means Japan, and “GYU” (牛), signifies beef.

This term is used to indicate certain breeds of Japanese beef that, thanks to the cross-breeding carried out over centuries as well as the specific and very particular breeding methods, boast a meat rich in intramuscular fat, the so-called marbling, very aromatic, sweet and healthy.
